BIOGRAPHY

The passion for motorcycles and motorcycling was part and parcel of everyday life in the home of the Fernández family. So much so that Augusto showed his interest in the sport from a very young age. At the age of six his father bought him his first motocross bike.

At the age of eight he began his training in Mallorca at the Chicho Lorenzo school, who is father to five-times World Champion Jorge Lorenzo.

He progressed and competed in national championships until making the jump in 2013 to the international stage when he joined the ranks of the European Junior Cup riding a Honda CBR 500R. He finished runner-up in that first season and in 2014 he competed again in the European Junior Cup and took the title.

In 2015, he competed in the European Stock 600 championship and claimed the "Rookie of the Year" prize by finishing in fourth position overall.

In 2016, he clinched Champion of Spain Stock 600 in the CEV with two races remaining and celebrated becoming "Rookie of the year" in the European Moto2 Championship.

Augusto made his debut in the MotoGP World Championship in 2017 when he rode for Speed Up in the Italian Moto2 Grand Prix. He stayed with the Italianbased project for the remaining 13 races of the year.

For 2018, Augusto moved into the Pons HP40 Kalex squad for the Grand Prix of Catalonia and he finished that season with the team before signing a permanent deal for 2019.

2019 was a year where Fernández showed his true potential and speed to finish collect 207 points from five podiums and three victories on his way to securing fifth overall in the final classification.

The Spanish rider showed his fighting qualities in abundance during a promising debut season with Team Estrella Galicia 0.0 Marc VDS.

Injuries played a key role in preventing Fernandez adding to his three Moto2 victories, but he continued to work with full commitment and motivation to finish 13th in the final rankings.

BIOGRAPHY

Sam's love of motorcycles runs in the family. His father competed nationally and passed on his passion for motorcycling to his children Sam and twin brother Alex, who started riding motorcycles at the age of six. They both started with motocross and at the age of 12 they made the leap into British Championships.

In 2014, Lowes appeared on the Moto2 World Championship grid after winning the World Supersport crown the previous year. After a first year of learning and gaining experience, the Briton achieved his first World Championship victory in 2015 with success at the Circuit of the Americas.

Four more podiums with the Speed Up structure allowed the Federal Oil Gresini team to secure his services for 2016. Lowes started as one of the favourites for the title and finished the year in fifth place with two victories and six podiums.

He remained in the Gresini set-up for 2017 when he made the jump into the premier class riding for Aprilia.

In 2018, he returned to Moto2 to ride the KTM for the Swiss Innovative Investors squad and 2019 resulted in another team and machinery switch. He wore the colours of the Federal Oil Gresini again and was back on a Kalex chassis.

Lowes produced the best form of his Moto2 career in his first season racing in the famous livery of Team Estrella Galicia 0,0 Marc VDS.

The Briton was one of the fastest and most consistent on the grid in 2020 and he took the title fight down to a thrilling final round decider, despite suffering a serious right hand injury in the penultimate round.

Lowes only lost the World Championship by nine-points at the end of a closely fought 15-round series in which he secured three victories, seven podiums and three pole positions to finish third in the World Championship.
